The Chief Administrative Officer advised that a report had been presented by the planner on the application for a temporary use permit for non-medical cannabis retail sales at 170 Cowichan Lake

Road.

He reported that all the public notices as required have been issued and all the statutory requirements have been met. He further advised that the proponent was available to discuss the application if Council would like to hear from him. The Town had received two letters on the application with one resident on Neva Road opposed and the other from the School District No. 79 advising that it had no comment.

The proponent, Steven Elkiw was on the telephone to speak on the matter and stated that he really looking forward to having the opportunity of doing business in the Town of Lake Cowichan.

The Mayor afforded Council members an opportunity to ask questions of the proponent.

Councillor McGonigle asked about employment opportunities that the business would bring to the community. Steve related that two or three cashier and management positions would become available and more as the company grows.

Further, Councillor McGonigle asked about the certification requirements and regulations affecting cannabis retail sales.
